APC's **work-integrated learning** programs aim to enhance students **employability skills** while assisting them to learn and prepare for their chosen profession or discipline.



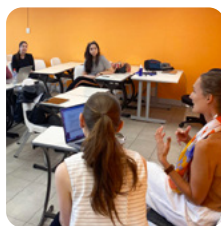
WORK PLACEMENT

- Is a mandatory component for some APC courses.
- Requires a specific number of hours, in addition to the scheduled course timetable.
- Provides students with an opportunity to gain work experience and expertise in a particular field.
- Allows students access to Work Placement preparation resources and documentation.
- Students will be expected to source a Host Organisation. APC can assist with this process and offer support.



PROJECTBASE

- Is an extra-curricular activity.
- Is offered to all APC VET students.
- Provides opportunities to work in real-world industry projects with real businesses and professionals.
- Is a Face-to-face on campus only program. Successful applicants must attend 100% of the sessions.
- Offers different projects at each campus, each term.
- Starts in Week 2 and finishes in Week 9 (8 weeks at 3 hours per week).
