I'm a freelance photographer both in Thailand and in Australia. In Thailand I take wedding pictures and organise light and sound for parties and other event such as graduations at universities. I also have a company called 'Gun-Eng' which teaches companies about team building. Initially I planned to study in the USA but failed the entry test. However, I'm glad to have had the experience of living and working here in Melbourne."
