ACADEMIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Completion of a one-year Diploma or Advanced Diploma or higher qualification in any discipline and four years full-time relevant workplace experience with at least two years in a supervisory or leadership role, **or** completion of Australian Year 12 Certificate or equivalent and four years full-time relevant workplace experience with at least two years in a supervisory or leadership role. **Plus** completion of the **Portfolio of Evidence** and completion of an interview to ensure suitability and commitment.

NOTE: if intending to pursue a pathway to a Master degree students may be required to have a Bachelor degree (refer to the individual university).

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

General English - Advanced Level; or English Proficiency Skills test result as per APC requirements.

ASSESSMENTS

Each learner will have the opportunity to apply the assessments either to their specific workplace or their areas of interest.
