## ACADEMIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Completion of a one-year Diploma or Advanced Diploma or higher qualification in any discipline and four years full-time relevant workplace experience with at least two years in a supervisory or leadership role, **or** completion of Australian Year 12 Certificate or equivalent and four years full-time relevant workplace experience with at least two years in a supervisory or leadership role. **Plus** completion of the [Portfolio of Evidence](#) and completion of an interview to ensure suitability and commitment.

**NOTE:** if intending to pursue a pathway to a Master degree students may be required to have a Bachelor degree (refer to the individual university).
